## **WSEM CHARITY CORNHOLE CLASSIC RETURNS TO MULBERRY'S**

**CLEVELAND (January 15, 2010)** – Over 50 teams will compete for four-baggers to win West Side Ecumenical Ministry's (WSEM) third annual Cornhole Classic at 6 p.m. on February 20 at Mulberry's, 2316 Mulberry Avenue on the West Bank of the Flats.

Hosted by WSEM's Junior Advisory Board, the competition pits team against team for cash prizes. All funds raised will help the nonprofit, social service organization serve Clevelanders in need through hunger assistance and outreach, workforce training and support, early childhood education and counseling.

Cornhole is a widely popular game in which players take turns pitching small bags filled with corn/beans at a raised platform. A bag in the hole scores 3 points, while a bag on the platform scores 1 point. The first team to score 21 points wins the game. A four-bagger occurs when each bag goes in the hole on the first shot.

At the Cornhole tournament, the two-person teams will compete in a double-elimination tournament to win cash prizes. The first place winning team will receive \$400, second place will receive \$200, and third place will receive \$100.

Team registration is \$70 and includes tournament entry, t-shirts, and adult beverages. Non-player admission for those who would like to attend the event is \$25. Attendees must be 21 and over.
